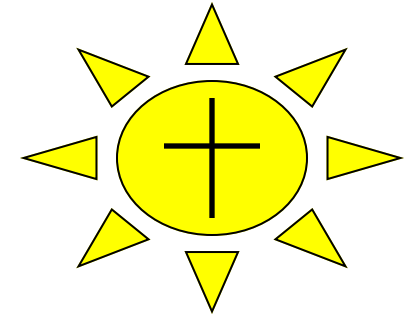

The Program...

Trinity's Summer Camp is fun and flexible but we do operate under a daily schedule. Art work, games, reading, swimming lessons, and snacks are done in the morning. Most field trips occur after lunch. Weekly activities and themes are posted on a weekly basis and are available to all families.
